WINEMAKING

DOUBLE SORTING TABLE BEFORE AND
AFTER DESTEMMING, THE GRAPES ARE
GRAVITY FED INTO TANKS.

PUMPING OVER CARRIED OUT DURING
FERMENTATION AS REQUIRED, ON A VAT
BY VAT BASIS.

FERMENTATION AT 28°C AND
MACERATION.

LONG AND GENTLE VERTICAL PRESSING.

MALOLACTIC FERMENTATION IN
BARRELS WITH 33% OF NEW OAK.

MATURING IN SEPARATE BATCHES FOR
12 MONTHS IN OAK BARRELS, 77% OF
WHICH HAVE ALREADY HELD ONE WINE.

PRODUCTION OF 55 000 BOTTLES.
